Cumulative GPA: 2.25 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission.

Transfer Credit: ESU will accept 64/65 credits from CCM, grades of "C" or better.

Scholarship – Clear Path Scholarship: Community College STEM scholarship for \$10,000 a year (see ESU website for more information).

Course Guide: Students completing an AS in Criminal Justice should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting courses.

Recommendations:

- Biology Electives – Take **BIO 201** Genetics & **BIO 202** Ecology
- CCM Biology core courses: **BIO 121**, **BIO 122**, **CHM 125/126**, **CHM 127/128** are equivalent to required major courses.
- Humanities Elective – PHL 111 or Foreign Language, HIS 166, HIS 167, HIS 114
- Social Science Elective – ECO 211, ECO 212, POL 111, SOC 120, SOC 216
- General Education Elective – Choose courses from Humanities and Social Science in different categories.
- Free Electives – Consider taking CHM 231/232 & CHM 233/234 or PHY 125/126 & PHY 127/128. Depending on concentration area – you may also consider BIO 101 & 102.
- Mathematics – Recommended to take **MAT 131** Calculus (but not listed as major requirement).
- See Bachelor's Degree completion plan in articulation agreement.
