Scholarship:

Course Guide: Students completing an AS in Criminal Justice should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting courses.

Recommendations:

- Mathematics Elective – Choose one MAT 110, MAT 124, or MAT 130
- CCM Criminal Justice core courses: **CJS121, 116, 221, 213**, are equivalent to required major courses.
- Humanities Elective – PHL 111 or Foreign Language, HIS 166, HIS 167, HIS 114
- General Education Elective - ECO 211, ECO 212, POL 111 or another Humanities in a different category.
- Criminal Justice Electives – Courses with direct equivalent: CJS 115, CJS 131 (strongly recommended), CJS 214, CJS 215, and CJS 224.
