Terms of the Agreement:

Cumulative GPA: 2.5 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission.

Transfer Credit: J&W will accept 63 credits from CCM. They operate on the quarter system – 63 credit hours is equivalent to 96 quarter hours. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better are transferrable.

Additional Requirements: Students must submit one of the following three approved certifications
1) National Restaurant Association Certification (NRAEF) 2) National Registry of Food Safety Professionals Certificate 3) Thomsen Prometric

Course Guide: Students completing an AAS in Culinary Arts should follow their curriculum checksheet and use this guide in selecting courses.

Recommendations:

- Math/Science/Technology Elective – students should take MAT 110 or higher to fulfill MATH General Studies requirement. Recommended: (choose one) **MAT 110, MAT 120, MAT 124, or MAT 130**
- Social Science or Humanities Elective – students should take **PSY 113** General Psychology
- General Education Electives 8 Credits – students should take a ¾ credit general education science course AND COM 109 Speech Communications. Students are required to have 8 credits of gen ed electives and will need to choose one additional course – consider ECO 211, SOC 120, or HIS courses.
