Terms of the Agreement:

Cumulative GPA: 2.5 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission.

Transfer Credit: J&W will accept 61/62 credits from CCM. They operate on the quarter system – 61/62 credit hours is equivalent to 88.5 quarter hours. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better are transferrable.

Additional Requirements: Students must present national exam certificate recognized by the Conference for Food and Protection – eligible in HOS 100.

- Social Science Elective – students should take **PSY 113** General Psychology or **SOC 120** Principles of Sociology
- Take **ECO 211** Principles of Economics, not ECO 113.
- General Education Elective –take **SPN 111** Elementary Spanish or **ECO 212** Principles of Economics II
- Take **ACC 111** Principles of Accounting, not ACC 110
- Take **HOS 210**, not HOS 223
- HOS Electives – take **HOS 234** Meeting and Event Sales as one of the electives
