Terms of the Agreement:

Cumulative GPA: 2.5 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission.

Transfer Credit: J&W will accept 58/60 credits from CCM. They operate on the quarter system – 58/60 credit hours is equivalent to 87 quarter hours. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better are transferrable.

Additional Requirements: Students must present national exam certificate recognized by the Conference for Food and Protection – eligible in HOS 100. Students must submit one of the following three approved certifications 1) National Restaurant Association Certification (NRA) 2) National Registry of Food Safety Professionals Certificate 3) Thomsen Prometric
