Terms of the Agreement:

Application: Application fee waived.

Transfer Credit: TESU will accept 89 credits from CCM. Students to transfer 22 credits above the AAS degree (67 credits).

Degree Completion – Required upper division nursing courses will be available online through the W. Cary Edwards School of Nursing.
