## AS in Science & Mathematics – Chemistry to BS Environmental Science or BA Environmental Science

### Terms of the Agreement:

**Cumulative GPA:** 2.0 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission to William Paterson University College of Science and Health

**Transfer Credit:** Students can transfer half of credits required for the major.

**New Jersey State-Wide Agreement Eligibility:** Students with an Associate in Science degree will have completed their general education (University Core Curriculum) requirements when transferring into BS or BA degree at William Paterson University under the SWTA.

**Graduation Requirements:** To fulfill the William Paterson University Requirements students must have 6 credits of Foreign Language.

**Course Guide:** Students completing an AS in Chemistry should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting courses.

### Recommendations:

- Take **two** semesters of **one** Foreign Language as the Humanities elective(s) and a General Education elective (American Sign Language can also fulfill the requirement).
- Take **BIO 121** General Biology 1 & **BIO 122** General Biology 2 as the Biology or Physics Elective.
- Take **PHY 125/126** General Physics 1 & **PHY 127/128** General Physics 2 as General Education Electives.
- Take **MAT 130** Probability and Statistics as Math or Restricted Elective.
- Take **ECO 211** Economics 1 & **ECO 212** Economics 2 as Social Science Electives.
- Take **BIO 127** Biology of Environmental Concerns as Free Elective.
- **CHM 125/126, CHM 127/128, CHM 231/232, CHM 233/234, MAT 131** will transfer as required major courses.
