Terms of the Agreement:

Admission Requirements: Application fee is waived.

CCM Graduates: Students must pass the NCLEX prior to beginning NUR courses, with the exception of NUR 3500 & NUR 3271

Transfer Credit: WPU will accept 90 credits from CCM. AAS in Nursing (66 credits) +24 credits (outlined below), must be "C" or higher.
