1) What competencies will you assess in 2005-06?

We assess the student's ability to perform a play, scene and character analysis and to produce the two main-stage productions.

2. In the drama program, students in the acting classes must produce a minimum of four scene-study projects which consist of memorized, blocked and costumed scenes from 'the canon'. A written document must be submitted along with each scene the student performs. The written document is in the form of a scene and character analysis along with a bibliography of sources consulted during the process.

3 .When will you assess outcomes this year?

The drama students must audition, produce and perform the two main stage productions. The fall production is SCRATCH.

The spring production will be selected from the following titles: OUR TOWN, LYSISTRATA or THE LARAMIE PROJECT. The decision will be made when we are told if we are going off-campus or will remain in the Davidson Room.

We also present a Student Showcase in May where students in the Acting and Directing classes present their final projects to the public.
