- Current New Jersey Registered Professional Nurse licensure. Licensure in another state will be reviewed on an individual basis. The licensee cannot have any pending disciplinary action against his/her nursing license from any Board of Nursing.
- Associate Degree in Nursing from an accredited institution or Diploma in Nursing if additional college credits have been completed.
- 33 liberal arts or science credits in addition to nursing courses.
